The Regional Joint Directors of School Education and District Educational Officers in the state are informed that due to amending the Rules 2(iii), 6,7,8,9,10 of G.O.Ms.No.32, School Edn.(Ser.II) Dept., dt.04.06.2017 there is no need for the teachers who have already applied for transfers through online to edit the relevant fields in their applications. The system will automatically generate the points as per their eligibility and will upload the modifications against their online Application.

As it has been facilitated to apply for request transfers in respect of teachers who have completed a minimum period of 2 Academic years of service in a school as on 30.04.2017, teacher appointed on or before 17.11.2015 may apply for request transfer. Such teachers should apply for transfers before 23.06.2017 by 5.00 P.M without fail.

The District Educational Officers in the state are therefore, requested to give wide publicity in their districts in the matter for awareness of the teachers through print media and also electronic media immediately.

ORDER:-

In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 78 and 99 of A.P. Education Act 1982 (Act 1 of 1982) and under Article 309 of the Constitution of India, Government of Andhra Pradesh hereby makes the following amendments to the AP Teachers (Regulation of Transfers) Rules issued in G.O.Ms.No.32, School Education (Ser.II) Department, dated 04/06/2017.

AMENDMENT

For the Rules 2(iii), 6, 7, 8, 9, and 10 of AP Teachers (Regulation of Transfers) Rules, following shall be substituted.

2(iii) Head Master Gr. II / Teachers who have completed a minimum period two academic years of service in a School as on 30th April of the year, in which transfers are to be taken up, shall be eligible to apply for transfer.

6 Entitlement Points – Common Points

Entitlement of points shall be awarded to the Headmaster Gr.II / Teachers service rendered in the present school, category as on 30th Aprilof the POINTS year in which transfers are to be taken up in the following manner:

(iv) For the Service 0.5 points for every year of completed service in the total service in all categories as on 30th April of the year in which transfers are to be taken up.
